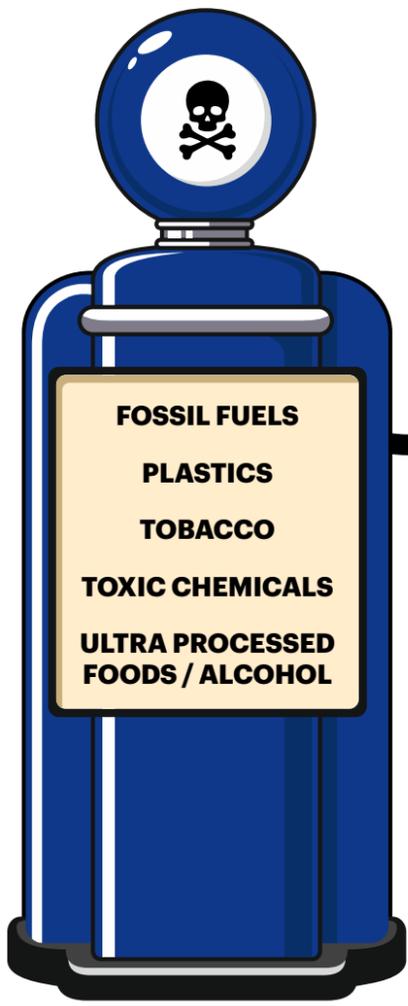




Countering Industrial Drivers of Disease

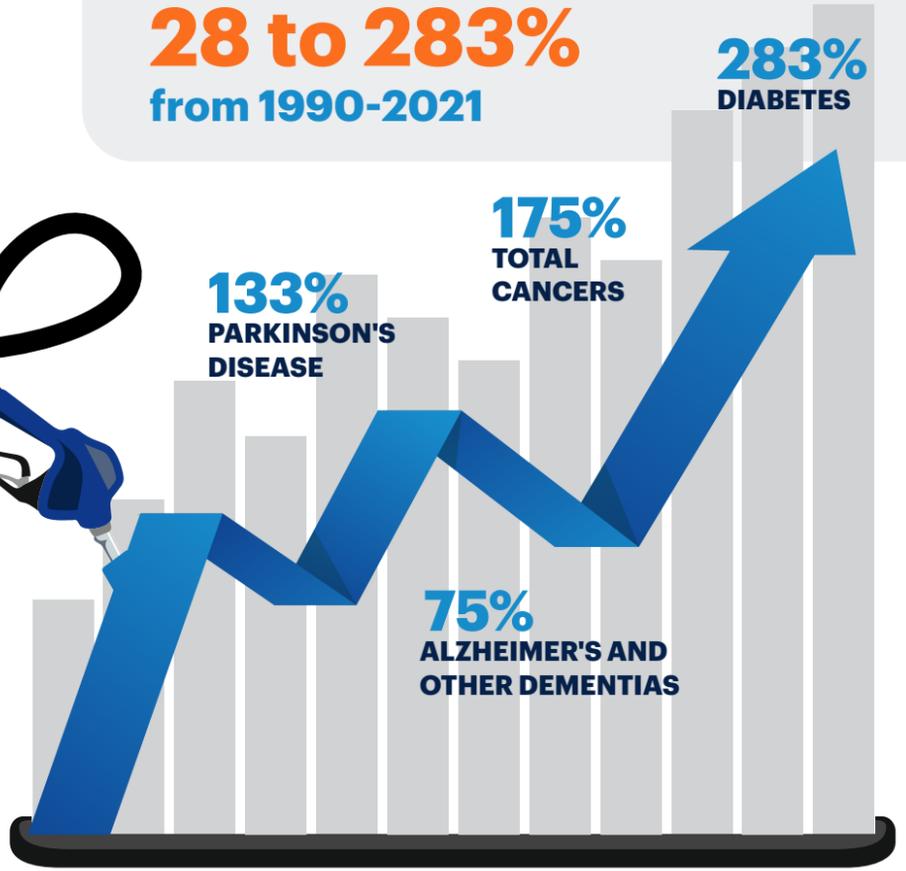
Fossil fuels, plastics, tobacco, ultra-processed foods, and alcohol have driven an alarming increase in non-communicable disease.
